The 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Greensboro Pride Festival will take place on Saturday, September 15 from 11:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. along South Elm Street in downtown Greensboro. Ferguson and Ruger are among performers who will take over the Ralph Lauren Stage at the intersection of South Elm Street and McGee Street.
